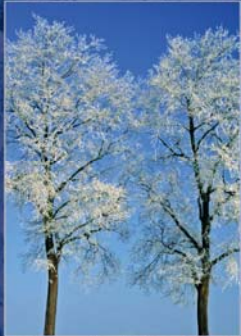

# University of Faith coming in February!

*From Brad...*



Every once in a while you hear something that simply "strikes a chord" within your soul. It resonates loud and clear and then leads you to one thought after another. I had the opportunity to hear lectures and visit with some of the best leaders of the church in Dallas last week. One of those people is Reggie McNeal who is a missional leadership specialist with an organization based in Dallas. He has also been a coach for church pastors as well as a seminary professor for many years.

McNeal said, "The church does not have a mission. The mission has a church."

What a simple phrase. What a simple concept that changes our entire thought paradigm. The mission has a church!

When Jesus called the disciples, he never mentioned the word "church". He called the disciples to participate in the mission of spreading the good news while loving, caring and assisting the poor, the broken and the outcast. He called the disciples to go out and be His hands and feet as they moved about in the world. It was to "the mission" that the disciples were called.

They were not called to a place to only be fed [yes, I understand that "feeding" is important] but were called to exercise their faith and be in mission. It was because of the mission that the church was formed. The establishment of the church was never the end goal and the phrase "come unto me" never meant simply coming to the "church".

The church is important and Paul continually lifted that up. But the church exists because of the mission. The mission does not exist because of the church. We are called to be in mission and ministry to the world.

It is a great paradigm shift. "The church does not have a mission. The mission has a church." I love that idea.

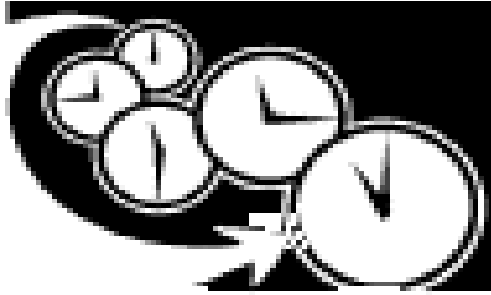

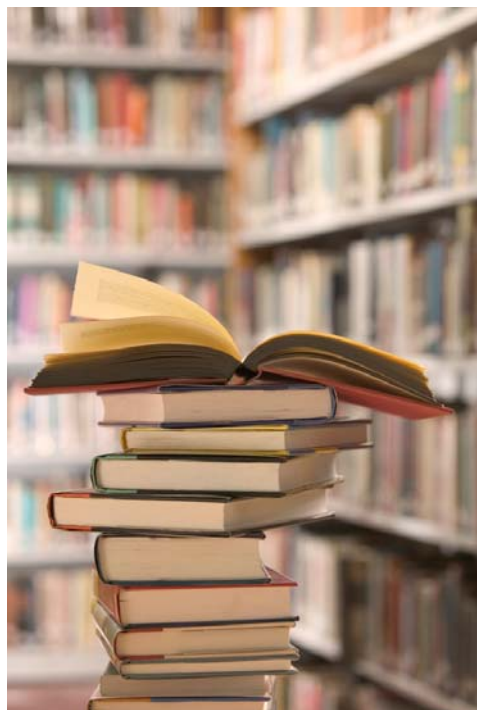
## News from the Reading Room

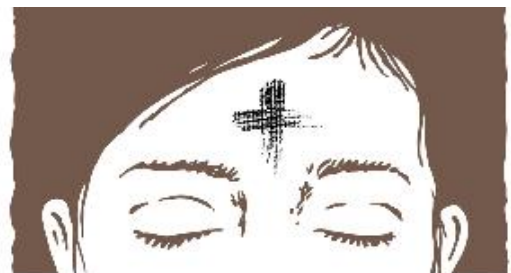

Here's a question for the "Ask the Pastor" column. Liz Black

Question: What is "absolute truth" ? What is " THE absolute truth " for a Christian?

Answer: The question of absolute truth is one that has been debated, like most such questions, for centuries. Plato argued there was an absolute truth but what we have on earth is mere shadow of an absolute that exists elsewhere. People much more learned and trained than I have struggled with the issue and therefore I will not propose that I have the absolute truth about absolute truth. I will also say that any answer I may give to this question will be inadequate in the space and time allowed and would probably be inadequate even if I had the space and time.

The existence of absolute truth implies that there is a truth that is ultimate, final and complete. It is the truth that cannot be debated or argued with because it is absolute and final. Absolute truth is generally discussed in contrast to relative truth or situational ethics [graded absolutism]. Most of the post modern world is operating in a paradigm of relativity [relative truth].

I personally believe in an absolute or final truth for I believe God is infinite, omnipotent, omniscient and complete. Therefore the absolute truth must rest within the being of God. If God is perfect, then the truth that is held within His being is also perfect and therefore absolute. It would also mean that His word and action is also perfect.

We can only know the truth that God reveals to us. If God is possessor of absolute truth then truth for the Christian has to reside in what God has revealed. God cannot reveal the entire truth for it is infinite and beyond our comprehension. However, we can know that which God does reveal to us. The Christian believes that Jesus Christ is the revelation of God and the bearer of God's truth. The core of the Christian faith is that God so loved the world and gave His son so that those who believe in Him will have eternal life [John 3:16]. The task for us is now to live out the truth as was revealed in Jesus Christ. Pastor Brad
