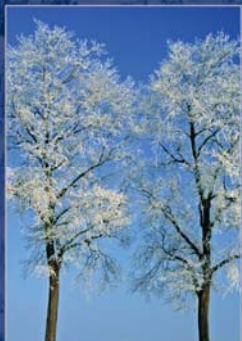

From Erma . . .



I have raised two boys and my house has been blessed with LEGO building blocks for the past 30 years! I step on them, suck them up in the vacuum cleaner and pick them up on an ongoing basis. I noticed a few years ago that LEGO pieces are more specialized – if you want to build an airplane, you buy an airplane set. If you want to build a robot,

you buy a robot set. LEGO stopped selling the set of basic bricks. It didn't take them long to realize how important these basic bricks were and they began selling them as "classic LEGO bricks."

There are some basic building blocks to have when receiving and providing care within a community. Some of these building blocks are knowledge about common issues people face – grief, health issues, addictions, financial struggles, or problems associated with aging. Other basic building blocks are simple skills needed to help people – listening, prayer, Scripture, availability, and faith in God.

Caring for others is something that can and must be learned, because Jesus calls us to care. In Jesus' first public appearance (Luke 4), he quotes from a passage in Isaiah that reflects a deep conviction for caring for people: "The Spirit of the Lord is on me...he has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners...And you will be called priests of the Lord; you will be named ministers of our God."

We are called to be priests and ministers. Any Christian can learn and practice the basic skills of caring for others. We simply need some basic tools, some "bricks" for understanding how to care. My hope and prayer is that our congregation will continue to discover better ways to care for others. In this new year we are making available some specific "building blocks" for developing our care ministry:

Beginning January 23 we will be offering (50) hours of Stephen Ministry training for individuals who feel called to be in one-on-one ministry with persons in our congregation and community who are experiencing difficulties in their lives. You will learn skills of listening, caring, praying, supporting, and encouraging. You will then become part of our Stephen Ministry Team and meet faithfully with a care receiver and the support team on a regular basis.

"The dogmas of the quiet past are inadequate for the stormy present. The occasion is piled high with difficulty, and we must rise with the occasion. As our case is new, so we must think anew and act anew".

The quote is accurate. We live in a stormy present as the world changes around us. On a global scale, the rise and fall of governments and economies brings a new situation daily. On a local scale, the rise and fall of companies force us to rethink every move we make.

I am mindful of the way our personal lives change. A new relationship means we now have to act anew. We have children and our lives must be reorganized to care for those children. Our children turn into teenagers and new issues that we have never wanted to face pop up. Our children leave home and we are faced with "the empty nest".
