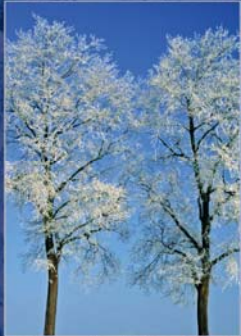

From Brad...



Take Up Your Cross

Once again, we offer you a cross to wear this Lenten season.

It is a reminder that Jesus Christ gave His life for us so that "whosoever shall believe in Him will have everlasting life". Let us remember that through His death we have forgiveness.

Our goal is not simply to remember but to share this cross with others. We invite you to share the cross with someone that you meet in your daily life. I was in a store once and the clerk said that she loved the cross I was wearing. I simply took it off and gave it to her and said "Here, wear this remembering that Christ died for you!" She said, "Really". I then shared with her that I was a part of Faith United Methodist Church and she was invited to come. It was just a simple witness to what I truly believe and our church family. You are challenged to wear your cross and share your cross with others. Use this season, not only as a reminder of what has been done for you, but also as an opportunity to share the message with others.

Fasting and Lent

We enter the season of Lent. The word originally simply meant "spring" but since the 5th century has been used to identify the 40 day fast before Easter. The Lenten season begins with Ash Wednesday. The season is

longer than 40 days. Sundays have always been considered a day of celebration as it began as a day of celebration of the resurrection. You therefore do not fast on the day of celebration. If you begin with Ash Wednesday and remove the Sundays, you have 40 days.

There is disagreement as to whether the early church actually fasted for the 40 days. Most scholars recognize that there was a wide variety of practices. However, there was always some sort of a fast. The essence of the fast is to deny yourself and concentrate on God. It is not simply for the sake of "ritual". The point is to rely on the power of God to deny yourself thereby bringing yourself closer to God.

We have modified this practice to simply "giving something up for Lent". Some very common things to "fast" on are coffee, French fries, chips, soda of all types, etc. Some people will give up red meat and others will give up bread. I have had members of congregations actually attempt to fast for the 40 days eating only bread. [I personally do not recommend such action in a fast paced world.] The point is denying yourself so that you will rely on God. Deny – Rely.

I challenge you to do something this Lent to concentrate on the power of God. There are millions of things you can do. Simply remember the guideline, Deny-Rely.

Ask the Pastor

The woman at the well Living water? never understood that parable!
Diane Stamm

Jesus answered her, "If you knew the gift of God, and who it is that is saying to you, 'Give me a drink,' you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water." – John 4:10



You've probably heard the story of the Woman at the Well. In the blistering heat of the noonday sun, a woman met Jesus when she came to draw water from the well. Jesus asks her for a drink, then says to her, "If you knew who you are talking to, you would have asked me for living water."

Living water was an Old Testament phrase that means "flowing water." It refers to a river or a stream rather than a pool or lake. Living water is clean and fresh, while standing water can become stagnant and unclean. Like he did so often, Jesus was using a phrase people knew to indicate something different.

Here, Jesus is not talking about the water in the well or in a stream, he is talking about new life – the new life that can be found in him. He is saying that the life of the world is like standing, stale, stagnant water. But, the life that is found in him is a clean, fresh, flowing river. In fact, the new life that Jesus gives never runs dry – it becomes a well of life bubbling up inside a person, refreshing and restoring them.

This story has become so familiar and favored because, like that woman at the well so many years ago, we all long for living water. We all crave the new and eternal life that Jesus offers.

Welcoming Church Certification



Faith UMC completed the required activities in 2011 for renewal of our Welcoming Church certification.

FUMC was initially certified in 2001 and is one of only 53 congregations to achieve renewal in 2011! This certification is designed to strengthen the church's welcoming ministry. Relatively few churches have this designation, with only 4 in the Tulsa area. The Hospitality Committee was responsible for the renewal process, which included documentation of six activities and communication with other churches via a web forum.

Participation in the Methodist web forum to exchange information and ideas with other churches going through this process has been very beneficial. We also received positive feedback that our goals, such as the improvement of the signage and entrance décor, were worthwhile and important in being a Welcoming Church. This process renews our passion to ensure that visitors are treated as our guests and that guests are shown that FUMC is a caring congregation that wants to be their church home. To be successful in this goal, we need everyone to participate in the hospitality ministry to welcome our guests throughout their visit.

Joplin Tornado Relief Mission Project April 22nd through 27th

On May 22, 2011, Joplin, Missouri was struck by an EF-5 tornado with winds in excess of 200 mph, measuring $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile wide and staying on the ground for 6 miles, causing widespread damage affecting thousands of people. While much work has already been done, our neighbors to the northeast still need our help. Faith is recruiting team members to volunteer for a week of helping those in need. While we do not yet know what our tasks will be, most likely it will be similar to work performed on Habitat for Humanity houses. What that means is that skills from painting to roofing will be needed: there will be an opportunity for any skill level to be used. All you need is a desire and willingness to help others.

If you can't commit to the entire week, we will have opportunities for those who want to serve for a day or two. Costa Rica Mission Trips

Faith United Methodist Church is offering 2 trips this year to Costa Rica – specifically, to Alejuela, (a suburb of San Jose, the capital city) in the central highlands - June 9th through 16th and July 28th through August 4th.

Room & Board is at El Centro Metodista, where the rooms are similar to dormitory rooms. Showers are hot and the food is tasty. The grounds are gated and include a chapel and swimming pool.

Work is going to be at the Center, doing some refurbishing, for the first group with trips to La Inglesia Evangelica Metodista Restauración for mission bible school and medical work. The second group will be doing construction work at La Inglesia Evangelica Metodista Restauración, running a mission bible school and doing eye examinations.

Tours will be on Sunday after church of downtown San Jose, and on Friday, we will take a site-seeing trip of lovely Costa Rica. In the past we have been to a volcano, rain forest, zoological park and coffee plantation.

Weather will be a bit cloudy with an afternoon shower. We are going to be there during the "wet" season with temperatures in the 70s and 80s and cooler in the evenings.

Money required for the trip is \$1,350, which covers all your costs from the time you leave Tulsa until you return (except for those priceless souvenirs). Please note that cost does not need to be a barrier. Contact the leaders for further details.

Anyone can go – youth and adults. There are no special skills needed, not even Spanish, as many Costa Ricans speak English and both your leaders speak Spanish. The only requirements are that you must have a passport, be flexible and have a desire to share Christ's love with your brothers and sisters in Costa Rica.
