Job Summary:

Ensure that all of the technical needs of a particular week's 9:00 and 11:00 worship services or a specific special event, and related rehearsals, are met with excellence.

Requirements:

- Demonstrated competence running FOH sound systems for large events
- Familiarity with necessary equipment and ability to learn new systems
- Ability to work in a positive Christian spirit with volunteers and other staff
- Computer skills with ProPresenter and Planning Center (can be learned on site)

Hours:

Tech Lead is committing to the following hours for each week served: Wednesday evening - P&W practice 7:45 pm to 8:45 pm; Sunday two services - 7:45 am to 12:00 pm.

Specific Responsibilities:

1. Run Front of House Sound for Praise Team Practice (Weds. Pm) and all Sunday morning rehearsals, sound checks, and Sanctuary worship services that week; or for that event.
2. Coordinate with volunteer slide presentation and camera operators for worship services.
3. Setup of audio-visual-lighting equipment for assigned worship services and special events. (Praise Team sets up their own equipment, but Tech Lead makes sure they have what they need to connect with house, and conducts sound check.)
4. Attend training along with volunteer technicians and/or more specialized training as determined by Director of Tech. Ministries.
5. Assist Director of Tech Ministries with maintenance, setup, or inventory tasks on scheduled Wednesday and/or Sunday, as needed.

Scheduling:

- Individual Tech Leads will be scheduled to lead technical ministries an average of twice per month. Scheduling may vary depending on everyone's scheduling needs.
- Tech Team Leads will be paid a flat fee per week (\$150) inclusive of 9:00 and 11:00 services and Wednesday evening practice.
- When asked to work a special event they will be paid the same flat fee and expected to work approximately 8 hours. (That may mean, for example, working two practices and a performance.)
